



**Call for an Unfixed-Term Contract as Research Technician with a Master degree
at IPO Porto**

Reference: LabTech-PAINLESS- Horizon Europe Research- Agreement N°101057367

The Administration Board of the Instituto Português de Oncologia do Porto Francisco Gentil, EPE (IPO Porto) opens a call for hiring 1 research technician with a degree, according to the Applicable Regulation, under an unfixed-term contract for up to 24 months, funded through Project PAINLESS (European Union's Horizon Europe Research and Innovation Program under Grant Agreement N°101057367).

This position will be integrated into Lab 2 of Centro de Investigação do IPO Porto (CI-IPOP, hosted at IPO Porto), in close integration with Molecular Oncology and Viral Pathology Research Group of IPO Porto.

1. Profile of the candidate:

Any national, foreign and stateless candidate(s) that hold the following requirements can apply:

- Degree holders in Physiology, Neurophysiology and related areas.
- Experience in Neurophysiology models research and clinical assessment namely in cancer patients.
- Experience in Neurophysiology research studies, use of EEG techniques (preferably in EEG and evoked potentials) and data collection and treatment.
- Excellent knowledge of Portuguese and English (spoken and written).

Note: In the event of the degree was awarded by a foreign higher institution, the degree must comply with the provisions of Decree-Law nr 66/2018, 18th August, and all formalities established there must be fulfilled by the applications deadline.

2. Regulation:

- Decree-Law nr 57/2016, from 29th August, altered by Law nr 57/2017, from 19th July,
- Portuguese Labor Law.

3. Members of the Jury:

According to article nr 13 from RJEC, the jury is composed by Rui Medeiros, PhD (who chairs); Ana Luisa Teixeira, PhD; Otilia Romano, MD; Cláudia Vieira, MD, PhD, and Maria Rosario Rodrigues, MD.

4. Start Date and workplace:

The contract is expected to start as soon as possible and until the expected execution date of the project, for a maximum period of 24 months, with the possibility of extension until a maximum of 48 months. The activities will be developed mainly at IPO-Porto, with occasional travel in the country and abroad.

5. Monthly remuneration:

Gross monthly Remuneration is 1 389,64€ correspondent to 1st pay band of the Starting Level of the scientific research career in exclusivity regimen, in accordance with the predicted in articles 1 and 2 of Regulatory Decree Nr 11-A / 2017, of 29th December.

6. Application process:

- a) Motivation Letter in English;
- b) Detailed CV in English;
- c) Degree Certificate;
- d) Certificate of Professional Experience in the field
- e) other documents that the applicant may consider to be relevant to prove the professional and scientific path.

Note: The non-compliance with these requirements determines the immediate rejection of the application.

7. Evaluation criteria:

The admitted applications will be subjected primarily to curricular evaluation, motivation letter and interview, in accordance with the profile described above using the following criteria:

- Detailed CV: Years of professional experience in the area of Neurophysiology and oncology; Certified experience in EEG techniques applied in research studies (execution, data collection, data treatment and statistical analysis) (60%); Scientific dissemination activities, namely scientific communications (scientific papers, letters to the editor, book chapters, oral and poster communications, awards) and participation in scientific meetings (20%)

This criterion will have a weighting factor of 80% of the total, on a scale of 0 to 100.

- Motivation letter: Interest and motivation for the research areas relevant to this position (10%), and written communication (5%).

This criterion will have a valuation of 15% of the total, on a scale of 0 to 100.

- Interview. This criterion will have a valuation of 5% of the total, on a scale of 0 to 100.

The final classification will be presented on a percentage scale from 0 to 100%. In the event of a tie, the decision will be made by the chairman of the jury.

After the evaluation of all admitted applications, the jury will write a meeting minutes with all processes of recruitment, evaluation and selection, including an ordered list of approved candidates and the final decision of the jury. The final decision of the jury shall be validated by the Head of the Institution, who is also in charge of deciding about the hiring.

8. Results: Both admitted and excluded candidates list and the final classification list shall be posted at IPO Porto and all candidates will be notified by email.

9. Preliminary hearing and final decision deadline: Pursuant to article 121 of the Administrative Procedure Code, after being notified, all candidates have 10 working days to respond. The jury's final decisions are pronounced within a period of 90 days, from the application deadline.
